COVID 19 School Plan
July 29, 2020

Arrival -

1. Each staff person will have his/her temperature taken (touchless) and recorded upon arrival on campus.
2. Students' temperature will be taken (touchless) at curbside while still in the vehicle. If temperature reading is above 100.3, parents will park the car so we can take a second temperature reading outside the car. If the child has a temperature above 100.3, he/she must return home.
3. Parents will not be allowed on campus until we get further clearance from County and State health departments. We will make an exception for Kindergarten parents on the first day of school.
4. Masks will not be mandatory. However, if guardians choose to have their child wear a mask, they will be allowed.

Classrooms -

1. Desks will be spread out to maximize the distance between children.
2. Hand sanitizer automatic dispensers (touchless), sanitizing wipes, and sinks with soap will be available in each classroom.
3. Children will sanitize hands every time they enter and leave the classroom.

Recess -

1. Fewer combined classes will occur at recess. No more than three classes will have recess at the same time.
2. Children will be encouraged to keep appropriate distance from each other, and staff will be supervising to ensure proper spacing.
3. Hand sanitizers (touchless) will be available for children to clean hands after recess.

Lunch -

1. We will use the picnic tables outside and the gym to spread the children out during three lunch periods (K-2, 3-5 and 6-8).
2. Children will wash their hands with soap and water before going to lunch.
3. We will have hand sanitizer available for children to use at lunch to clean their hands before lunch and after lunch.

Library -

1. Children will be required to clean hands with hand sanitizer prior to touching library books.
2. The number of children in the library will be monitored to ensure that proper spacing is followed.
3. Returned books will be cleaned prior to being put back into circulation.

Chapel -

1. We will alternate grades in church for attendance and the rest will participate via live streaming in the classrooms.
2. Hand sanitizer will be available as children enter and leave the church.

1. Children will be required to clean the computer workstations in the library after use.
2. Middle school children will be assigned specific chromebooks and required to clean them daily.
3. PE equipment will be cleaned daily by PE Teacher.
4. Classrooms, restrooms and offices will be cleaned and disinfected daily by our custodial staff. They will use a product similar to Microban 24.

Parents -

1. Our website will be updated as changes occur with new information
2. Urgent information will be communicated via our phone messaging service
3. One on one meet and greet with teachers will be scheduled before school starts.

Sick Children -

1. Children who become ill during the day will be sent to the office to be evaluated.
2. If a child has a temperature of 100.4 or higher, we will isolate the child in our sick room.
3. The child's parents will be contacted to come and pick up their child.
4. After the child leaves, we will disinfect the sick room and other areas where the child has been.
5. If we receive a report of a child testing positive for the Covid 19 virus, we will inform our school families.
6. The classroom(s) the affected child was in will be thoroughly cleaned and disinfected.

Major outbreak of COVID 19 again -

1. If the State enters into another lockdown due to a spike in cases and closes businesses, we will need to offer online classes to 3-8 graders. Teachers will provide direct instruction using Google Meet. Parents and teachers will work together to develop a plan for students who require supplemental instruction.
2. K-2 may be allowed on campus in smaller groups for direct instruction.
3. If anyone in a family's household tests positive for COVID 19, the child will need to be quarantined for two weeks before he/she can come back to school. This is to protect other families and staff from becoming exposed to the virus.
4. If a student tests positive, the county Public Health Department will be notified immediately.
5. Distance learning will only occur if we are required by the State to close due to a major breakout of COVID 19.
6. St. Peter Lutheran School will immediately notify local health officials of any children reported to us who test positive. We will dismiss students and most staff for 2-5 days. This initial short-term dismissal allows time for the local health officials to gain a better understanding of the COVID-19 situation impacting the school and for custodial staff to clean and disinfect the affected facilities. We will work with the local health officials to determine appropriate next steps, including whether an extended dismissal duration is needed to stop or slow further spread of COVID-19.
